Fourth of July Events

July 4 – Steinhatchee – at dusk the fireworks are shot off the 10th street bridge by the community center. FWC holds back boat traffic but you can anchor in the Steinhatchee River to the west and east of the bridge. Food and glow sticks will be sold at the community center.

July 5 – Cedar Key Lighthouse – this is one of several openings to the public to visit Seahorse Key home of the Cedar Key Light Station. Visit the island either by your own boat or plenty of transportation available at the Cedar Key City Docks.

July 5 – Town of Suwannee – an all day event starting at 10:00 a.m. with vendors lining the street – a golf cart parade during the day and fantastic fireworks show starting at dusk.

July 5 – Horseshoe Beach – another all day event with lots of family fun, fresh local seafood, great BBQ, food vendors, entertainment and ending with another night sky filled with a firework show.
