This event will take place on Saturday, August 14, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. on the Suwannee River.

We will conduct this cleanup on both sides of the river from Hart Springs in Gilchrist County to Hinton Landing in Dixie County covering all three counties, Dixie, Gilchrist & Levy.

There will be 3-different cleanup routes: Hart Springs to Otter Springs, Otter Springs to Suwannee Gables Motel, Suwannee Gables Motel to Hinton Landing.

You will launch at one of these 3-locations and end at the assigned spots. Launches will begin 9:00 a.m. you should reach your destination no later than 1:00 p.m.

We have 12 canoes available (must call to reserve at (352) 463-3467) As well participates can bring their own canoes. First 50-registrars will receive a T-shirt and goodie bag.

Transportation will then be provided to Hinton Landing for the post cleanup party, which should begin around 1:15 p.m. We will provide a free complimentary lunch (sponsored by Progress Energy) to all who attend and a chance to win some great door prizes. Transportation back to your vehicle locations will also be provided.

If you are not sure about volunteering in a canoe we can still use your help at several spots such as: Help at launch/exit sites, help set-up Hinton Landing for lunch, help serve lunch, help with cleanup after event at Hinton Landing, etc.
